ALPHA COMPETITION 1.8/2.0T MQB Turbo Inlet Pipe


Install Guide

• Loosen the 8xT25 bolts from the airbox lid. (red circles img 1)

• Remove the vaccum hose from the airbox pulling it back gently. (red arrow img 2)

. Using hose clamp pliers, remove the intake hose clamp. (red arrow img 3)

• Remove the OEM airbox lid. (img 4)

• Loosen the turbo inlet pipe rear clamp with a screwdriver or a 7mm socket. (purple circle img 5)

• Pinch both sides of the PVC flange fitting...and (red arrows img 6)

• ...pull the fitting to pop it off the turbo inlet pipe.(blue arrow direction img 7)...

• Loosen the T30 screw on the turbo/inlet pipe and leave it secured on the turbo.(red arrow img 8)

• Rotate the turbo inlet pipe toward the dashboard by +/- 20° and pull the pipe away gently.(red arrow direction img 9)

• Make sure both o-rings supplied are in good condition and use lub to help installation.(img 10)

• Fit the turbo inlet pipe into the turbo and rotate it by 20° toward the front end of the car. (red arrow direction/counterclockwise img11)

• Check that everything is clean and ready for reinstallation in reverse order.

• After everything is reinstalled correctly, start and test drive the car. Check for any vacuum, intake or oil leaks.
